- 1** Scenic drive through lush farmland to Rainbow Mountain. Short bushwalk to Crater Lake to view an explosion crater against a backdrop of bare brown, orange and red steaming cliffs. View Boiling Mud Pools.
- 2** Riverjet 45 minute scenic ride on the mighty Waikato (NZ's longest river) - bring your cameras and enjoy the history, the wildlife and spectacular scenery.
- 3** Orakei Korako Geothermal Wonderland. Come and explore a world of gushing geysers, hot springs, bubbling mud pools and some of the largest and most amazing silica terraces in the world.
- 4** Time to find out how one of the world's best inventions can handle - the Hamilton Jet - you will be amazed by the way these boats can spin and excite you. The 30 minute return trip is even more adventurous experience the world famous spins and thrills.
- 5** Your helicopter awaits at the Riverjet base to whisk you away along the Volcanic fault line over Wai-O-tapu Thermal Wonderland and Waimangu Valley landing on the iconic Mount Tarawera Volcano. A short walk around this amazing natural attraction to appreciate the full force of the 1886 eruption which killed more than 100 people.

Rainbow Mountain: The Maori name for Rainbow Mountain is Maungakakamea, meaning 'mountain of coloured earth'. It is easily recognised by its coloured slopes and its unusual rounded knob on the top, known as Tihi-o-Rua, 'the owls perch'. From its volcanic origins, the mountain has cooled over recent years, although in places it is still visibly smouldering.

Mud Pools: In 1925 New Zealand's largest mud volcano was eroded by heavy rain. The vigorously active mud pools now occupying the site provide one of the best opportunities to photograph and experience the unique character and sounds of erupting mud. It is an ever active and changing landscape and very soothing for eroded urban nerve endings.

NZ Riverjet: Jet boat down the Waikato River through the spectacular Tutukau gorge where the canyon walls rise dramatically up to 50 metres above the water and hear the tales behind past events. On the return journey experience the iconic ability of a Hamilton jet boat as our experienced driver/guide thrill you with 360 degree spins.

Orakei Korako: Cross the beautiful Waikato River between Rotorua and Taupo and discover Orakei Korako Cave and Thermal Park. Also known as the Hidden Valley, Orakei Korako is a unique visitor attraction – not to be missed. It's a geothermal wonderland, one of nature's true gifts.

Mt Tarawera: Fly with HELIPRO and land on the summit of sacred Mt Tarawera, then try to comprehend the earth forces which created this awe inspiring volcanic icon. Standing on the summit offers unobstructed views of the volcano's magnificent craters, domes and our Lakes district which is beautiful beyond belief. Complimented with informative commentary, this is much more than a flight. It is an experience to remember.
